## CURVATURE TOOL GUIDE

### Where to Find the Curvature Tool

You can select the tool from your toolbar or use the keyboard shortcut Shift + ~

### Create Curves with Single Clicks

By default single clicking with the tool will create points that curve. After creating your first point, you will see a rubber band preview of how the line will look if you place the next point where your mouse cursor hovers.

### Create Corner Points & Straight Line Segments

Double Click (or hold down the Alt (PC) or Opt (Mac) keys) to create sharp corner points or a series of straight line paths. These straight lines and corners can easily be converted to curves. (See Toggling)

### Toggle Points Between Curves and Corners

If you double click with the curvature tool on a point that already exists on your path it will toggle between a curved point and a corner point.

### Adding Points to a Path

Hovering over the path and clicking will create a new point.

### Removing Points from a Path

If you select a point with the curvature tool and hit the Delete key, it will remove the point from the path and reacquate the path to remain as smooth as possible.

### Exit Active Path

Use the Escape Key to exit the active path you are drawing.

### Moving a Point on a Path

You can click and drag any point on a path to move its position.

**SHIFT** +

Single Click = **CURVES**

Double Click = **CORNERS**

Double Click Points to **TOGGLE**

Click on Path to **ADD** a Point

Select & Remove with **DELETE**

Exit Active Path with **ESCAPE**
